-Once the dua has been learnt, the easiest way to make sure that it is not forgotten, is by reciting the dua whenever the occasion to read arises.

If this dua is recited at the time of dressing,
then Allaah forgives the past and future sins.

"Ya Allaah, let this moon (month) pass over us with blessings, Iman, safety, and in the belief of Islam. Grant us the ability to act on the actions that You love and pleases You. (O moon) My Rabb and Your Rabb is Allaah. (Hisnul Hasin)
